LITURGICAL PRACTICES TO HALT SPREAD OF COVID-19

Due to the ongoing Pandemic and the International health initiatives to halt the spread of Covid-19, the following practices are continued at St. Philip the Apostle Parish:

- Handshake of peace will be expressed through a bow or wave
- Eucharistic Ministers and clergy will Sanitize hands before and after distribution of Holy Communion
- Communion from the Cup is temporarily discontinued
- Communion reception on the tongue must be received from a priest

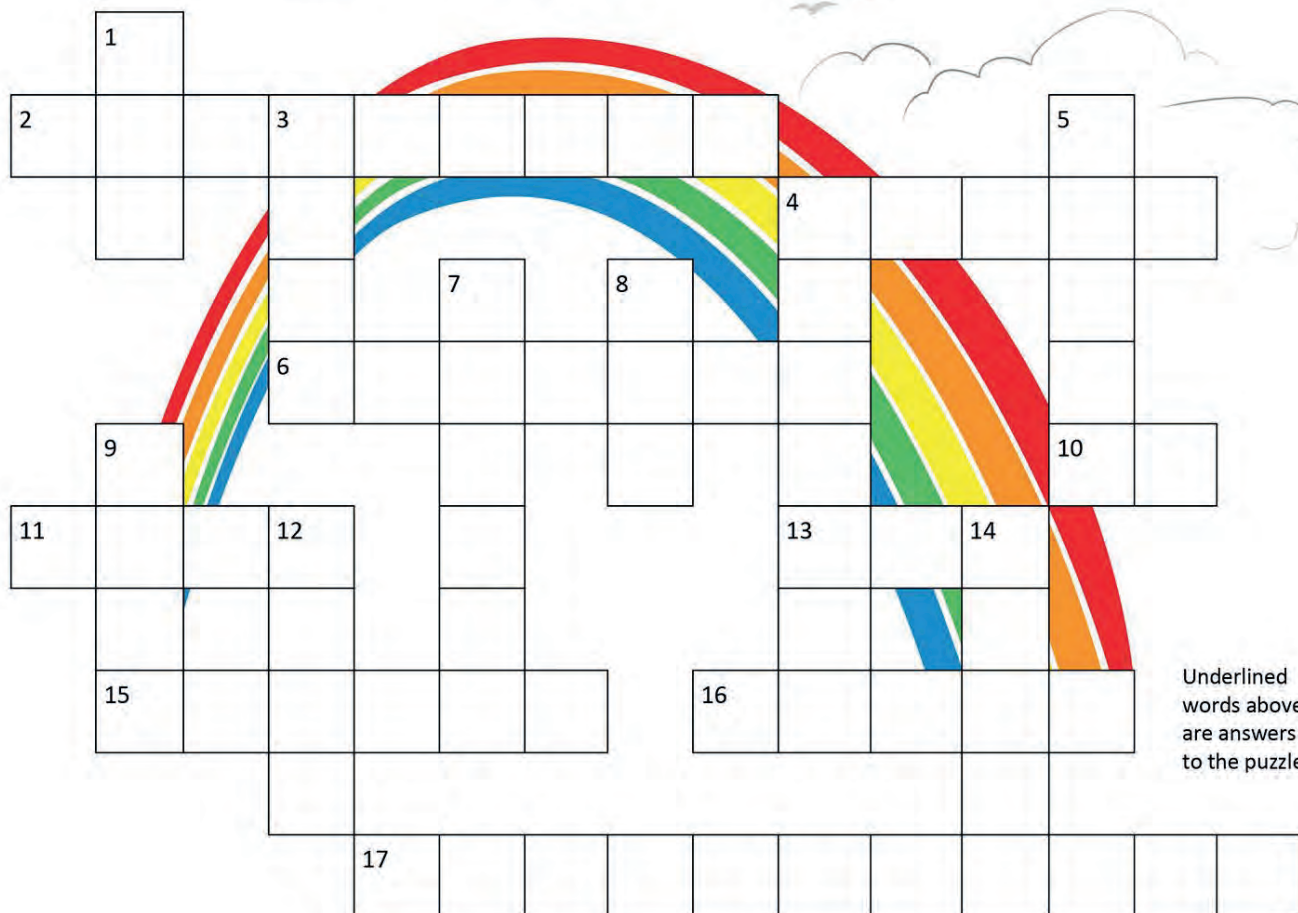
