

# "WHY, FATHER?" by Fr. Emerson

\* "Why do we ask for the prayers of the saints? Can they hear us?"

We ask the saints to pray for us because they are alive in Christ! Scripture says, "God is not the God of the dead, but of the living" (Luke 20:38). The saints are part of the Communion of Saints, our spiritual family in heaven, who love and intercede for us before God.

#### **Diblical basis:**

- **Revelation 5:8** The saints offer our prayers to God as incense.
- **Hebrews 12:1** "We are surrounded by a great cloud of witnesses."
- James 5:16 "The prayer of a righteous person is powerful."

They "hear" us not by human power, but through God's grace, which unites heaven and earth. Asking their prayers doesn't replace God — it strengthens our bond as one Church in Christ.

# \* "Why do we pray for the dead? Is Purgatory in the Bible?"

We pray for the dead because love never ends after death. Heaven is pure holiness, and Scripture says, "Nothing unclean shall enter it" (Revelation 21:27). Those who die in God's friendship may still need cleansing from sin's effects — that merciful purification is what we call **Purgatory**.

#### Biblical basis:

- 2 Maccabees 12:44–46 Praying for the dead helps free them from sin.
- 1 Corinthians 3:15 A person is "saved, but only as through fire."
- Matthew 12:32 Jesus speaks of forgiveness "in the age to come."

Purgatory isn't punishment — it's God's love perfecting souls for heaven. Our prayers, sacrifices, and Masses hasten their joy and express the mercy of Christ.


